Just a reminder, members must be current with membership for at least 12 consecutive months to be eligible to submit or nominate someone for an application. (See attached guidelines). The deadline to submit an application for the drawing is **April 20, 2022**. The application must be mailed in. You can also email the application, but you are required to mail and email it to make sure we receive the form. The winners names will be drawn at the May 1, 2022 General Membership Meeting. Please read the Guidelines for information on where to send the applications.

Please also note there is a requirement to submit a 150-200 word essay titled "**How has the Czech or Slovak Culture and/or Heritage Influenced or Impacted My Life.**" This essay is to be written by the individual who has been nominated for the Scholarship.
